Red Cross Helps Victims Displaced by Multi-Family Home Fire in Hyannis

At 6:15 a.m. this morning, the Red Cross was called to the scene of a fire on 161 Winter Street in Hyannis. It involved a multi-family building, impacting four families, including several young children.

Nine Red Cross volunteers, from as far as Bourne and Brewster, and two Emergency Response Vehicles rushed to respond to a special call from the Hyannis Fire Department. 13 People were placed in a hotel for the next few nights and received replacements for lost clothing. In addition, they received food for their stay. A mental health volunteer was present to support the victims. The volunteers also provided relief for the first responders.
