***Instructors Needed for American Red Cross CPR and First Aid classes on  
Martha's Vineyard***

Hyannis, Mass, August 11, 2008 – The American Red Cross, Cape Cod and Islands Chapter is looking to train CPR and First Aid Instructors to teach classes on Martha's Vineyard.

Instructor training courses will be held at the Chapter House at 286 South Street in Hyannis on Saturdays September 6 and 20 from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm. The cost of the course is \$145.

This course trains you to teach basic level American Red Cross First Aid, CPR and AED courses for lay responders. These courses include Standard First Aid, Standard First Aid with AED, Adult CPR, Adult CPR/AED, Infant & Child CPR and First Aid.

**PREREQUISITES:** Must demonstrate current knowledge of and skills in American Red Cross Adult CPR/AED, Infant and Child CPR and First Aid at the first session. If you do not pass the skills test, the instructor cannot continue in the class and no refund is issued. Fundamentals of Instructor Training (FIT) are included with the course. The minimum age for instructors is 16.
